

ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES AND SPECIAL HONORS

Many of our students have had the advantage of worthwhile experiences and activities which have enriched their lives and increased their effectiveness in their classes. Some of these include the following programs:

1. Tours to various points of interest in our local community, in surrounding areas in distant areas - New York, Washington, California and foreign countries.
2. Summer Programs
 - a. Yale Summer High School and Morehouse Summer High School
 - b. Institutes - Science and Math, Aerospace, Humanities, Music, and French, and National Defense Guidance Institutes.
3. The Advanced Placement Program sponsored by Hampton Institute for more than seven years for English, Biology, and Calculus classes.

The school boasts of one Merit Scholar and one Honorable Mention. Since the beginning of the Negro National Achievement Program sponsored by the Merit Scholarship Corporation which began eight years ago, Phenix has had five National Achievement Scholars.

During the last ten years about 45 percent of the graduates entered college and sought degrees in varied fields. They studied and succeeded at all of the leading predominantly Negro Colleges, and they also succeeded at many integrated schools.
